REGISTRATION

- Each school can register a maximum of 3 participants + 2 supplementary climbers for the individual categories/divisions. Each school can register a maximum of 1 team (4 members) and 1 Mixed Double (2 members) for each team relay categories/divisions.
- Closing date for registration: **Fri, 3 Jul 09 at 12pm.**
- Registration Fee for different categories are as follows:
S\$15 per person – Individual Category
S\$25 per team – Mixed Double Speed Category
S\$50 per team – Speed Team Relay Category
- Payment can be made in cash or cheque upon registration. All cheques are to be made payable to “Singapore Mountaineering Federation” and submitted with registration forms duly signed. **Forms and cheque can be dropped off at: Singapore Mountaineering Federation, Blk 2 Balestier Road #03-641 Singapore 320002**

ATTIRE

- An event T-shirt and number tag will be issued to each participant upon reporting on the event day. Participants are required to wear the T-shirt during their climb.
- Only participants for the Team Relay are allowed to don their school team attire during their climb.

JUDGING

- **Difficulty Event**
Participants will be judged by their legitimate hold-touch point; height reached by dynamic means is allowed. Should more than one individual reach the same height in the finals, a super final will be held to determine the winner.
- **Speed Event**
The fastest participant wins. All participants shall have one attempt each.

TIMING

- **Difficulty Event**
Timing will begin when both legs clear the ground. The maximum time allowed to scale the wall will be decided by the President Jury and made known to participants before the competition starts.
- **Speed Event**
Participants are given a maximum of two minutes to complete the climb. For the Team Relay, the fastest team is determined by the total timing of all three participants. A maximum of three minutes per team is given.

TERMINATION OF CLIMB

- A participant's attempt will be terminated by the route-judge should he/she:
falls; exceeds the permitted climb time; uses part of the wall (e.g. side edges) for climbing; uses artificial aid; returns to the ground; fails to clip-on the runners in the correct order (difficulty event); or fails to clip-on after the trailing leg crosses over the runner (difficulty event)

DISQUALIFICATION

- A participant will be disqualified if he/she:
is late for the reporting; fails to return to the isolation zone after observing the route; unropes while climbing; uses unapproved modification of equipment; or fails to wear the competition attire provided by the Organisers.

APPEAL

- All appeals have to be made in writing by Teacher-in-charge within 30 minutes / 10 minutes during Finals after the results and will be handled by an appeal panel.
- A charge of \$50 (cash) will be levied for each appeal.
- The money will be refunded to the participant if his/her appeal is successful.

PRIZES

- Medals will be awarded to top 3 winners of each category.
- Trophies will be awarded to “Fastest Male”, “Fastest Female”, “Fastest Male Team”, “Fastest Female Team”, “Fastest Mixed Double” and “Overall School Champion” titles only.
